Tirzepatide (Brand name Mounjaro®)

We anticipate a lot of demand for this BUT there is a nationally set roll-out programme which limits eligibility for many years. Every year additional patients become eligible but for the first year only a tiny number of patients are eligible – a small amount of our patients have been identified as meeting the criteria for this year. The eligibility for this year is ONLY if you have a BMI of 40 or over AND have four or more of the following health conditions:

- · Type 2 diabetes,
- · High blood pressure,
- · High cholesterol,
- Sleep apnoea,
- Cardiovascular disease

AND a clinician considers it appropriate treatment.

The vast majority of our patients do not currently fit this criteria and if you don't fit the criteria we cannot offer you this medication this year. We are not allowed to prescribe outside of the set roll-out programme.

PharmacyFirst

This service allows you to be seen more quickly via your local pharmacist for minor conditions – you don't always need to see a GP.

- Impetigo (aged 1 year and over)
- Infected insect bites (aged 1 year and over)
- •Earache (aged 1 to 17 years)
- Sore throat (aged 5 years and over)
- •Sinusitis (aged 12 years and over)
- •Urinary Tract Infections (UTIs) (women aged 16 to 64 years)
- Shingles (aged 18 years and over)



NHS Friends & Family Test (FFT)

The NHS Friends and Family Test (FFT) was created to help service providers and commissioners understand whether patients are happy with the service provided, or where improvements are needed. It's a quick and anonymous way to give your views after receiving NHS care or treatment.

Patients receive a text message after their appointment inviting them to complete the test. We encourage patients to complete this as it allows us to monitor the services we provide. Out of 2,795 responses, 2,486 patients rated us as "Very Good" or "Good"
