Tech Help

Do you, or someone you know, need help with downloading and using the NHS app?

You can use the app to

- Order repeat medications
- Manage appointments
- See test results
- Find out the status of your referrals
- · Keep track of documents relating to your care.

PharmacyFirst

This service allows you to be seen more quickly via your local pharmacist for minor conditions – you don't always need to see a GP.

- Impetigo (aged 1 year and over)
- Infected insect bites (aged 1 year and over)
- •Earache (aged 1 to 17 years)
- •Sore throat (aged 5 years and over)
- •Sinusitis (aged 12 years and over)
- •Urinary Tract Infections (UTIs) (women aged 16 to 64 years)
- Shingles (aged 18 years and over)



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Seasonal Vaccinations

Flu Vaccinations

So far just over 5,000 eligible patients have been vaccinated against the flu.



The practice continue to offer those eligible, with a flu vaccination. The clinician (Nurse or HCA) will also offer this if you have an upcoming appointment. You can also call the practice to book an appointment.

The seasonal influenza vaccination programme runs until 31st March 2025.

Its likely that the practice will hold their main flu vaccination clinics at Chard Young Peoples Centre again for 2025/2026.

RSV Vaccinations

The RSV vaccine helps protect against respiratory syncytial virus (RSV), a common virus that can make babies and older adults seriously ill. It's recommended during pregnancy and for adults aged 75 to 79.

We are also offering the vaccination to those turning 80 after September 2024.

If you would like the RSV vaccination, then please speak to a member of the team who will be happy to book you an appointment.

COVID Vaccinations

The winter COVID vaccinations have now come to and end. Bookings will reopen via 119 or online during the spring.

NHS Friends & Family Test (FFT)

The NHS Friends and Family Test (FFT) was created to help service providers and commissioners understand whether patients are happy with the service provided, or where improvements are needed. It's a quick and anonymous way to give your views after receiving NHS care or treatment.

Patients receive a text message after their appointment inviting them to complete the test. We encourage patients to complete this as it allows us to monitor the services we provide. Out of 1,973 responses, 1,796 patients rated us as "Very Good" or "Good"
